in what manner , or to what
extent an action is performed.**

- When : He ran **yesterday**
- Where : He ran **here**
- How : He ran **quickly**
- In what manner : He ran **barefoot**
- To what extent : He ran **fast**

Types of adverbs

- Manner
- Frequency
- Time and place
- Relative time
- Degree
- Quantity
- Focusing
- Attitude markers
- Carefully, slowly
- Always, often, never
- Now, here
- Already, recently, soon
- Extremely, rather, very
- A lot, a little
- Even, also, only, particularly
- Apparently, fortunately

to think about

RULES

- For most adjectives, add **-ly**
Patient - **patiently**
- For adjectives ending in **y** change the **y** to **i** and add **-ly**
easy - **easily**
- For adjectives ending in **c**, add **-ally**
automatic - **automatically**
- Some adverbs of manner are irregularas that is that they don't end in **-ly**
good - well
- Some irregular adverbs have the same form as the adjective
fast - fast

Adjective	Adverb	What changes?
beautiful	beautifully	Adjective + LY
slow	slowly	
bad	badly	
happy	happily	Adjectives that finish in -Y change -Y by -I and add LY
noisy	noisily	
easy	easily	
good	well	Irregular forms
fast	fast	
hard	hard

extremely

- This hamburger tastes (awful)

awfully

- Be with this glass of milk. It's hot.(careful)

carefully

- Robin looks What's the matter with him? (sad)

(terrible)

Terribly

- This steak smells (good)

well

- Our basketball team played last Friday. (bad)

badly

- Don't speak so I can't understand you. (fast)
