## Singular and Plural Nouns



## There are 6 ways to change a noun from sangular to plural.

- A noun is a person, place, or thing.
- Singular means only one noun.
-Plural means more than one noun.

Rule 1
Most nouns become plural by adding " $s$ "

boy book<br>desk<br>school<br>boys<br>books<br>desks<br>school

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## Rule 2

## Nouns that end in "ch", "sh", "s","x", "O" add "es"

bush<br>box<br>church

bushes
boxes
church

## Rule 3

## Nouns that end in " $f$ " or " fe " often change to "ves".

wife<br>wolf<br>wives wolves<br>Sanuji Karunasekara

## Rule 4

Some nouns change the inside spelling

man<br>goose mouse<br>men<br>geese mice

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Nouns that end in a consonant letter and "y", drop the " y " and add "ies".
sky
puppy
donkey key
skies
puppies
donkey
key
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## Rule 6

## Some nouns do not change when making them plural.

wheat
deer
fish
corn
wheat
deer
fish
corn
